Note: The Sustainable Forest Initiative images on Recycle Logos Type J and L for the earlier issues of Seabiscuit and Liberty Bell vary in height according to the size of the envelope - Size 12 = 16 mm, size 21 = 18 mm and size 23 = 20 mm. All subsequent issues are printed with a SFI logo height of 16 mm.
